Day camps have a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 participants. Early registration is encouraged! Blake Cazier and Stephanie Love, your instructors, share over 30 years of combined outdoor education experience. Program fees include transportation, equipment and instruction. All summer camps include meeting the draft horses and sled dogs, kayaking, rock climbing, team building challenges, hiking/orienteering, swimming and other camp activities. The Youth Mushing Camp includes snowshoeing, horse drawn sleigh ride, winter camping/survival skills and ice safety. Meet at Marshall School Parking Lot, 1215 Rice Lake Road, Duluth, at 8:30 am. Pick up campers at 4:30 pm. Program locations at Positive Energy Outdoor (ed)Ventures, 15 miles north of Duluth, and various Duluth sites; details provided in registration packet. Bring a bag lunch, water bottle, sunscreen and raingear. Youth Mushing Camp has a separate clothing list and meets from 9 am – 4 pm. Youth Mushing Camp February 18-20 (\$250)
