For youth who have completed grades 2-6 and grades 7-12

Day camps have a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 participants. Blake Cazier and Stephanie Love, your instructors, share over 40 years of combined outdoor education experience. Program fees include transportation, equipment and instruction. All summer camps include meeting the draft horses and sled dogs, kayaking, rock climbing, team building challenges, hiking/orienteering, swimming and other camp activities. Meet at Marshall School Parking Lot, 1215 Rice Lake Road, Duluth, at 8:30 am. Pick up campers at 4:30 pm. Program locations at Positive Energy Outdoor (ed)Ventures, 15 miles north of Duluth, and various Duluth sites; details provided in registration packet. Bring a bag lunch, water bottle, sunscreen and rain gear. Enjoy a picnic and slideshow on the final day of each summer camp. Registration form on back.

Youth Outdoor Leadership Program: June 14, 16 and 18 (\$50)

For youth who have completed grades 7-12. Learn the skills you'll need to assist with Positive Energy's outdoor programs: climbing, kayaking, team building, renewable energy, draft horses, sled dogs and more. After a 3 day leadership and skills training, you'll be ready to volunteer with Positive Energy's day camps and youth programs throughout the summer, teaching younger children the skills you have learned, and acting as a positive role model. 25-50 hours of additional volunteering is required for participation in this program.

Horses and More Day Camp: June 21-25 (\$250)

For youth who have completed grades 2-6. Spend the mornings with Tracy and Blaze, our gentle draft horses, exploring draft horse history, care and grooming, harnessing and driving.

Girls' Outdoor (ed)Ventures Camp: July 5-9 (\$250)

For youth who have completed grades 2-6. Want to try a little of everything? Our Girls' Outdoor (ed)Ventures camp is for you!

Kayak Day Camp: July 19-23 (\$250)

For youth who have completed grades 2-6. Join us at our private inland lake waterfront for a week of fun in a kayak. Positive Energy is the only outdoor program in the region to offer youth sized kayaks designed for smaller paddlers. Explore kayak styles, including single kayaks, tandem

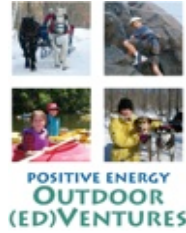

Teen Climbing Camp: August 23-27 (\$250)

Campers will receive personal attention and coaching as they learn or improve climbing skills, including safety skills, knots, belaying, rappelling, climbing and teaching techniques. Campers will have the opportunity to join Positive Energy's Twin Ports Climbing Team and assist with climbing programs for younger youth as they develop their climbing and teaching skills.
